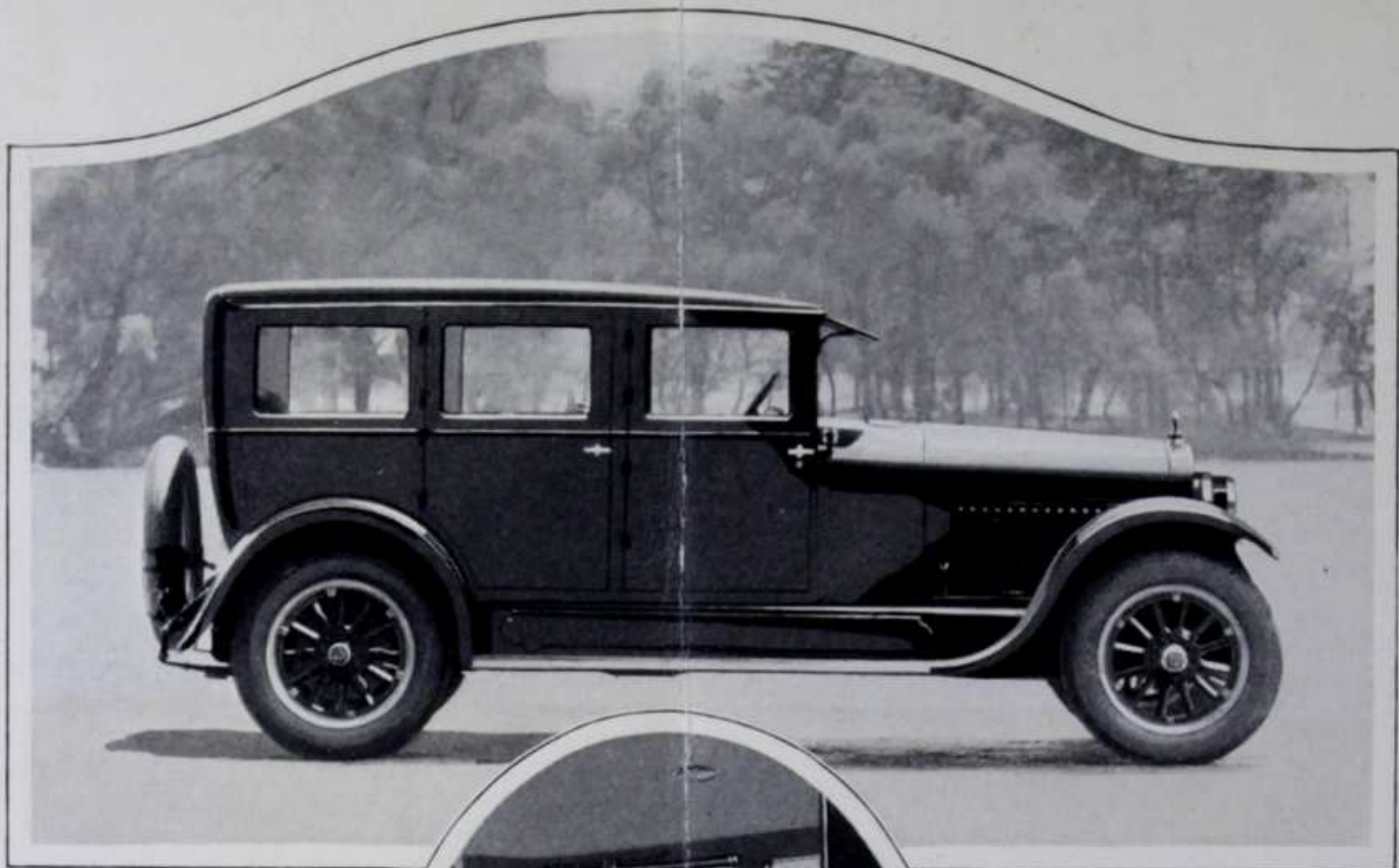
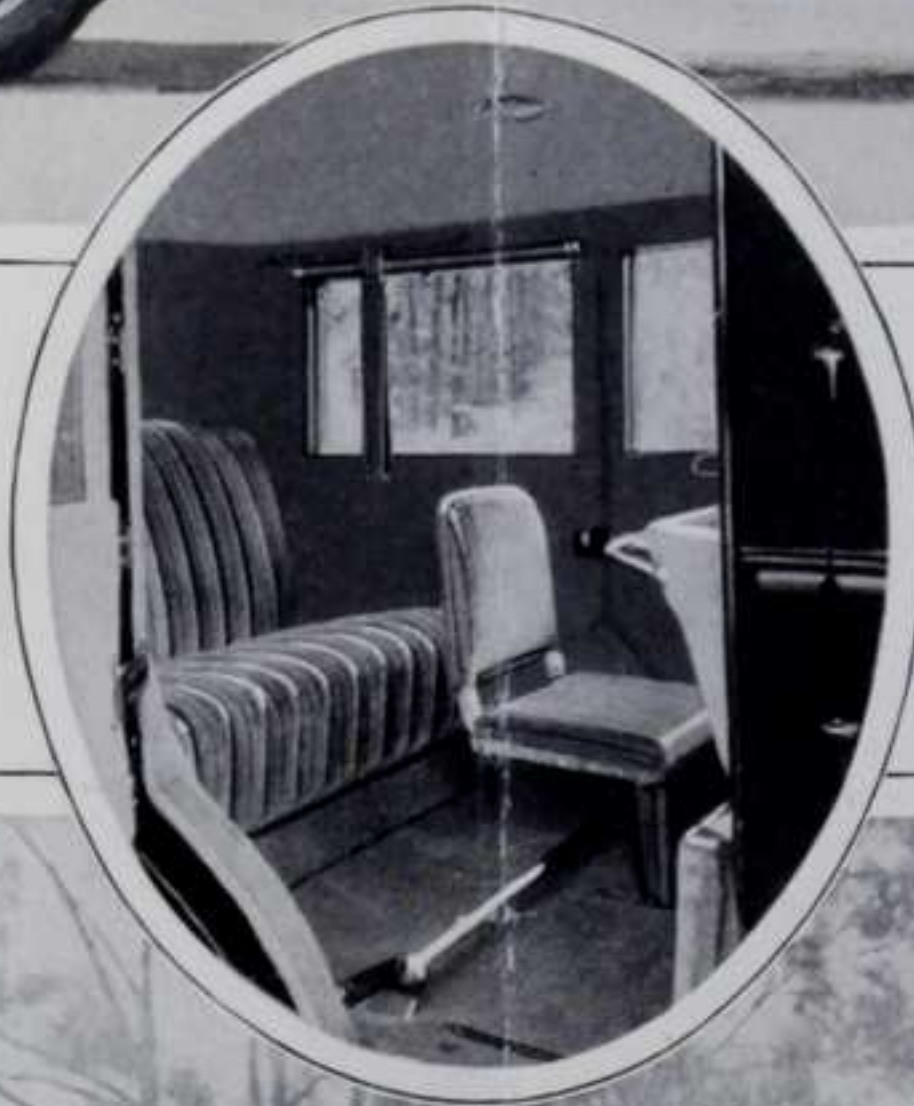




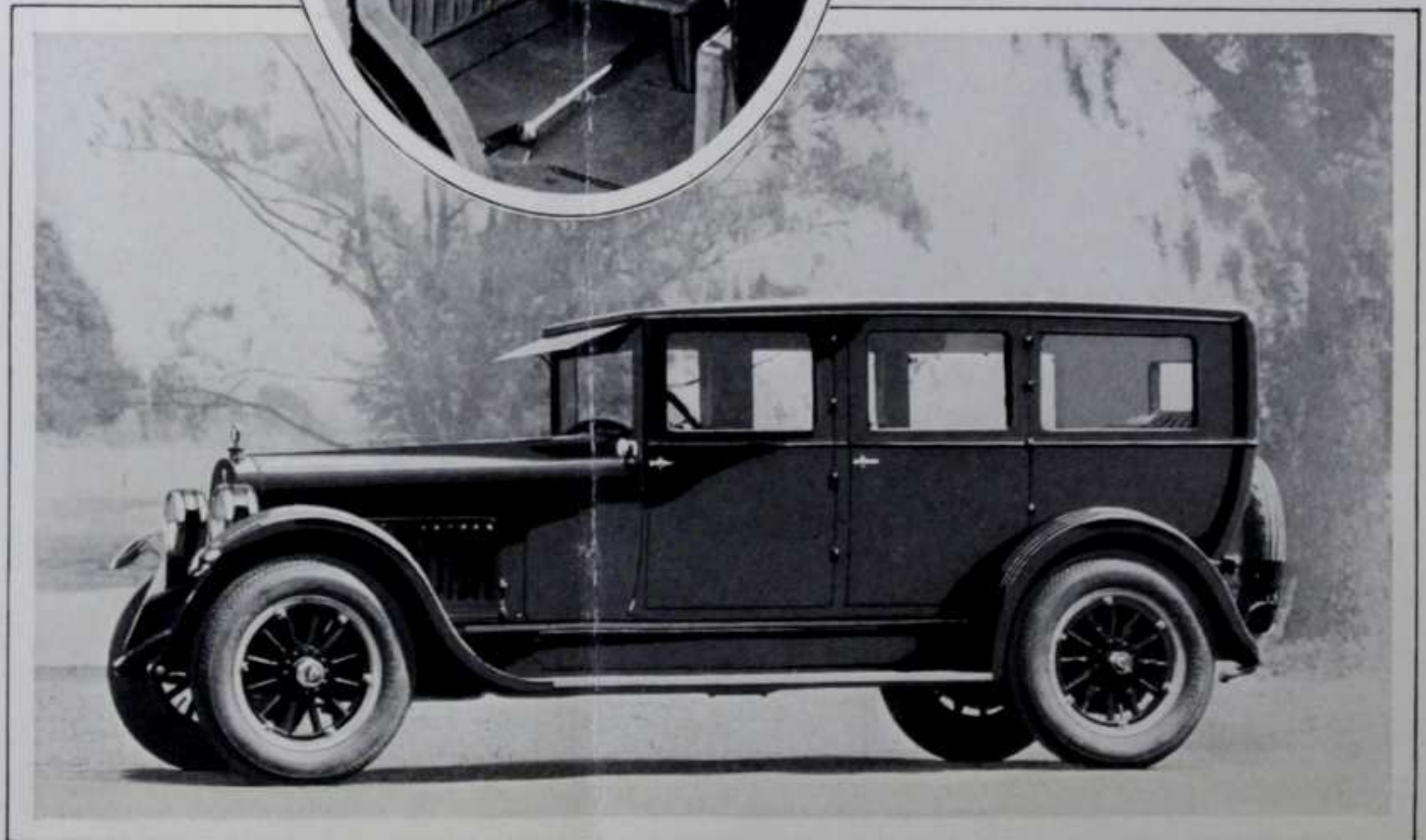

The cars are offered either in the full seven-passenger size or in the five-passenger arrangement. In either case the seating accommodations are entirely ample and comfortable. With balloon tires the comfort and luxury of riding are especially pleasing.

It is believed that the Sedans' clean-cut and symmetrical lines will immediately commend themselves to those accustomed to fine things. The prevailing color is the characteristic Hudson blue, set off with a double hair line stripe of a somewhat lighter shade. A pleasing contrast is gained through the use of jet black fenders and radiator shell, and an ornamental molding which streamlines gracefully around the body. All details of finish

are conformable to the latest vogue. Genuine balloon tires enhance the appearance as well as riding comfort.
