We desire to call your attention to the Waterproof Suits we are making for Yachtsmen.

Our garments will not stick together in warm weather, are not stiff and clumsy as the oil suit, and are absolutely water-tight. These suits are used by the U. S. Life Saving Service, who recommend them highly. The goods are made up in suits consisting of short coat and trousers. We have also long coats, 48 to 52 inches long, according to length desired. They are made in same sizes as oil clothes. In ordering give size of oil clothes worn, or else breast and sleeve measure.
