Your favour of yesterday has been received, enclosing two dfts on Boston for \$1000 each & Saml Brooks' note with your endorsement - The latter I have handed to Mr Anous, & hope he will be able to get it discounted, tho' it appears that money becomes more scarce every day - This day I received a remittance from New York on your account in which was included a draft of \$1000 on Hill & Lathbridge of ~~for~~ which has not been paid & will be returned tomorrow under protest - I shall therefore be under the necessity, as the \$1000 cannot be expected back in time, to sell both the dfts on Boston which I hope to be able to do on good terms considering the sight they are at & the fluctuating state of exchange -
