OLD COAL HOUSE - UPPER YARD

This was an additional Coal House for burning Charcoal built in the late Eighties in the Upper End of the Eleutherian Works and located on the switch which ran into the works from Montchanin on the Wilmington and Northern R.R., now part of the Philadelphia & Reading R.R. system. This location was commonly known as the "Wilderness". The two Coal Houses nearer the Refinery were very much older than this one having been built in the early stages of the works. The New Soda House is just beyond this Coal House on the same R.R. spur.
