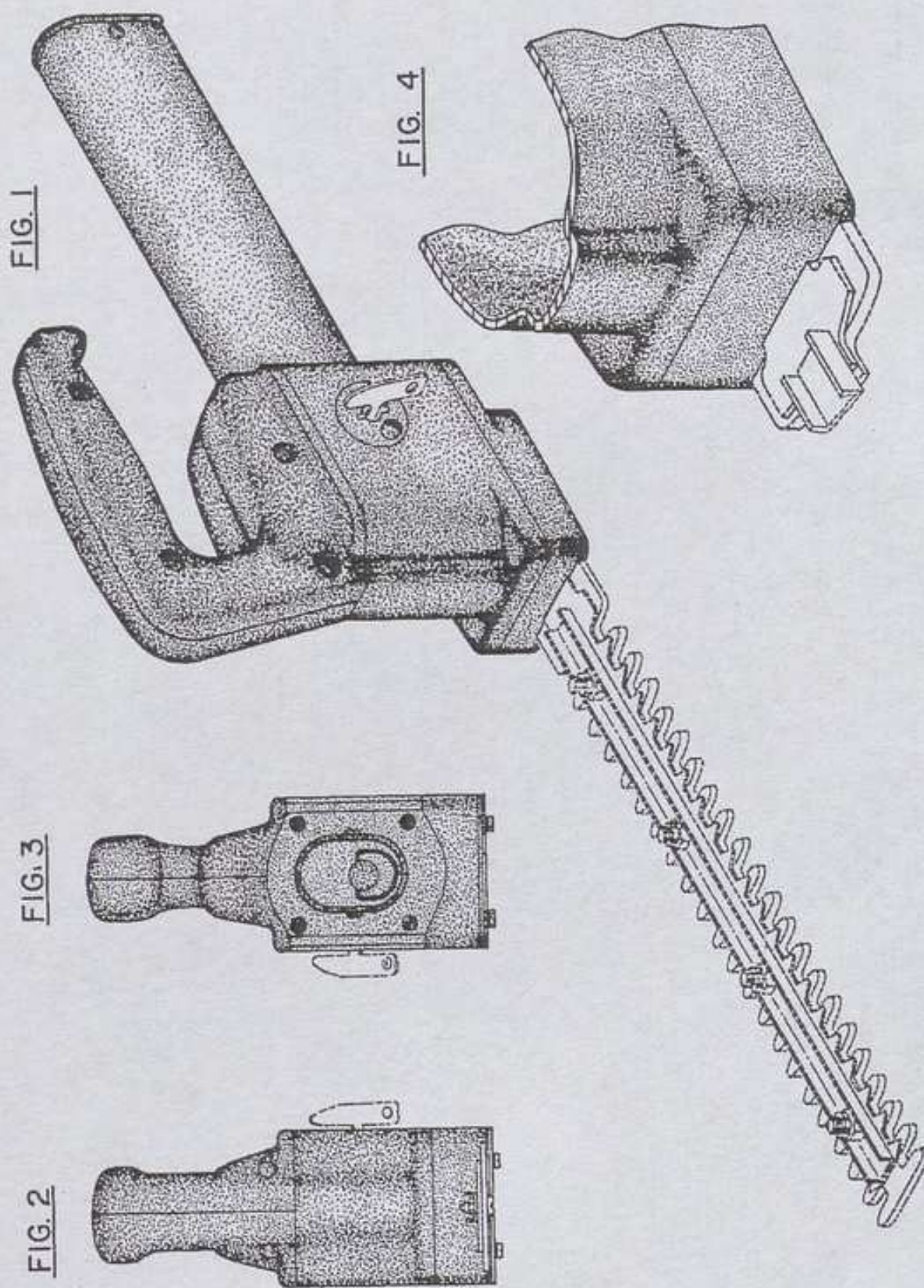

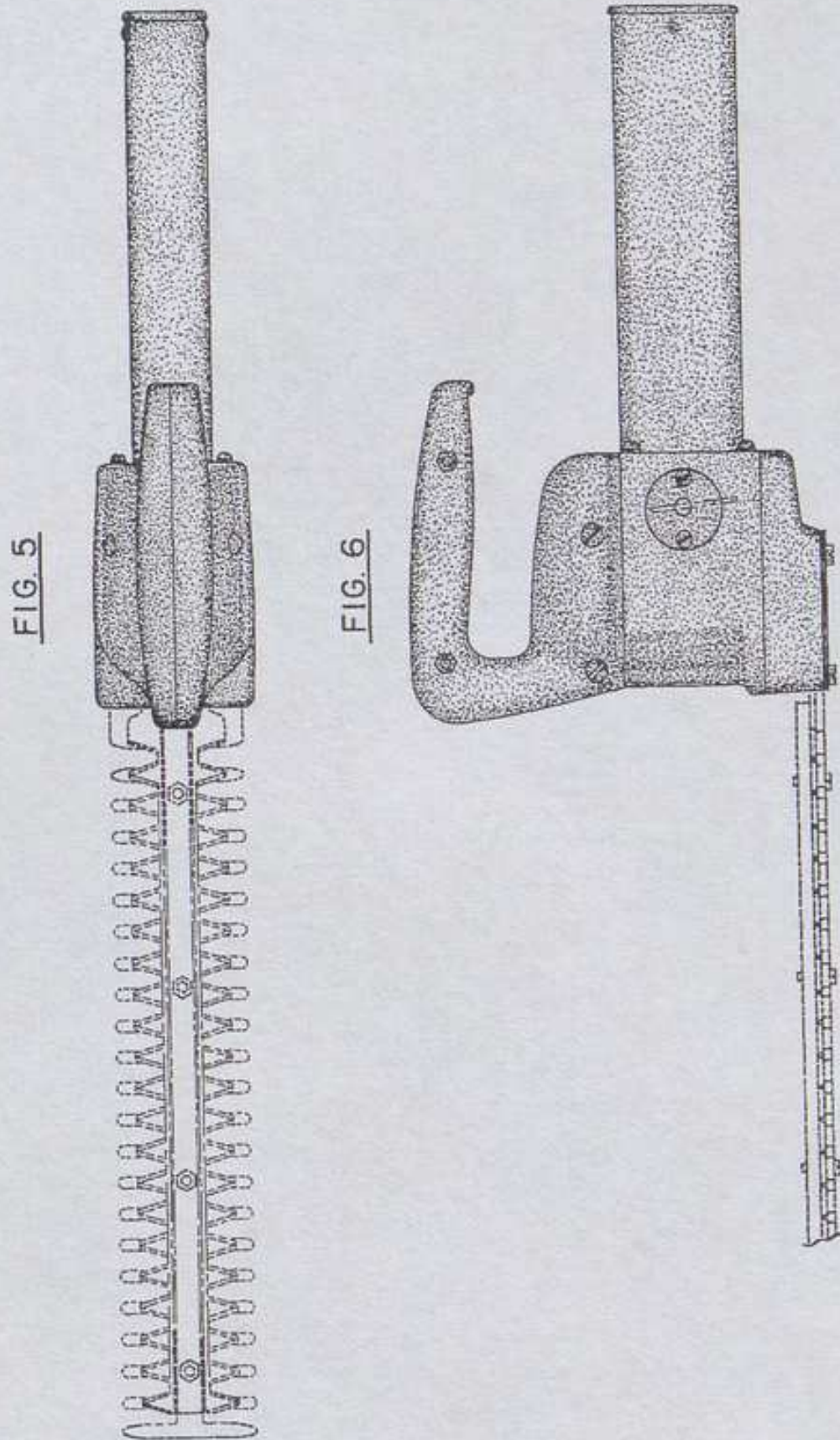


FIGURE 1 is a front perspective view of a hedge trimmer or similar article embodying my new design;

 FIGURE 6 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being substantially the same as the side shown and the cutter blade being broken away for convenience of illustration.
 The dominant features of my design reside in the full line portions of the drawing.
