STACKS

At Thos. Moser, we believe that all things made by hand, big or small, are equally worthy of considered design and precious resources. These small boxes are made of the same walnut and cherry we use in our furniture, and have been designed to stack in threes, either in the same or varying sizes. Treated with a food safe finish, the underside of the lid of each box may be used as a cutting surface for cheeses, for example, and the bowl for crackers and other snacks.

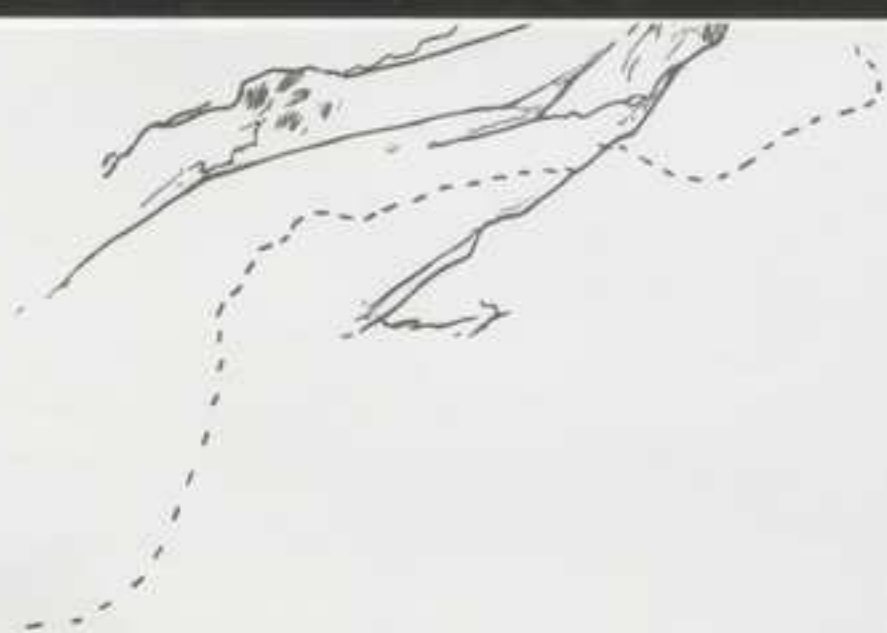

Tom's son and master craftsman, Andy Moser, furthered their idea, and in summer 2014, the boxes were awarded as a trophy to the winners of each class of the Beach to Beacon 10K Road Race, nationally recognized as one of the top road races in the country. The Beacon Box, like all Thos. Moser furniture, is handmade at our shop in Auburn, Maine and incorporates dovetail joinery, signifying Thos. Moser quality and craftsmanship.

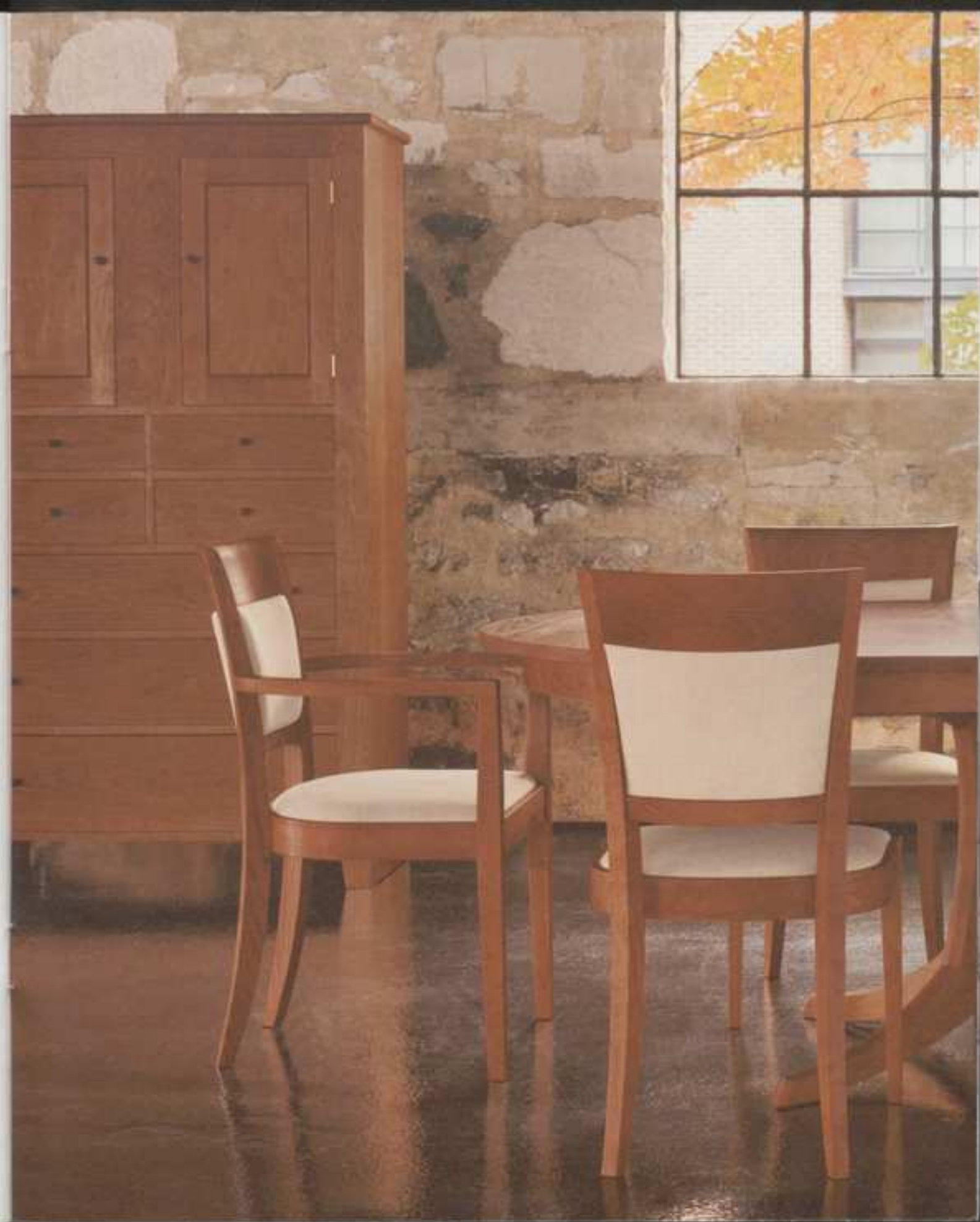
